SCOS Auction - October 22, 2012

- Our annual auction is just around the corner. Always exciting and interesting, this is the opportunity to round out your collection of one area or take it in a new direction to another. We will have blooming orchids, species for the specialist, and orchid supplies to carry you through the next potting season.
- As members, consider the opportunity to thin your collection, donate plants to the auction, and make room for new orchids. Over the next month, the auction committee members will be collecting and labeling plants and supplies in preparation for auction night.
- The night of the auction, there are jobs that must be accomplished to make the auction run smoothly. The doors open at 5:30 p.m., and someone must set up the chairs and tables, bring in the plants and display them, and set up locations for registration, tabulation of results, and final checkout. During the auction, one group is needed to bring items up front to be auctioned, and another group is needed to label and place them in the correct location after the hammer falls. After the auction, a group is needed to support the process of checking out and getting the correct plants to the correct bidders. Finally, all the chairs and tables need to be taken down and put away. If you can volunteer, see someone from the auction committee at our next (September) monthly meeting.
